

# ASL CLASSIFIERS

## Cheat Sheet

Classifier	How it is used
CL: 1	A thin, long object. A person, legs, outline, pencil, toothbrush
CL: 3	A vehicle (must be horizontal) or three people
CL: 4	Line of people, lines on shirt, water leaking, bleeding, four people, fence, hair, certain types of traffic movement, bandwidth, streaming, download
CL: 5	5 - Wind, air movement, flowing porous objects (light, water, shower), projectile motion (vomit, flood, tears), upright blurred scenery, traffic (jams, freeways), filters/screens, stiff hair (Mohawk, fur), large flat objects (platter, lid), flames, eyelashes (flirt), fan blowing, leaves moving Bent 5 - movement of animals with more than 4 legs, recording Claw 5 - larger amount of people animals, settings location
CL: A	Fixed objects, positioning, commuting, back-and-forth motion, declining actions
CL: B	B - Flat smooth surfaces, height, width, horse, bicycle Bent B - long road Curved B - curved object like a basin or sink
CL: C	C - cylindrical object like cup, pole, pipe, thick things Partial C - beak, pinchers
CL: F	Small round objects, holding tiny items, eyeballs, distractions, flying insects, Polka dots, buttons, coins, eye gaze
CL: G	Thin object, size of stripe, thickness of object, putting on jewelry, eyelid movement
CL: I	Very thin objects like string, spaghetti, high heels
CL: S	Holding something, pan, suitcase, broom, mop, your head, throwing an object
CL: L	L - Square objects like A frame or driver's license Bent L - Check, card, square, lake or pond, pan, tiara/crown, pan
CL: O	Cylindrical object like firehose, rod, pipe
CL: V (CL: 2)	Upside-down - Person standing and/or walking 2 - eyes, two people Bent 2 - bent legs, animal legs, smaller animal, seated larger animals
CL: X	Crouched posture, scratching/digging tool, hooked objects (anchor, talons, fishing hook), curved sliders (skis, skates), bent leg motion (running, cross-legged), convertible top movement
CL: Y	Wide objects, large person/animal, hippo's mouth, pouring, height measurement
CL: ILY	Airplane, jets
